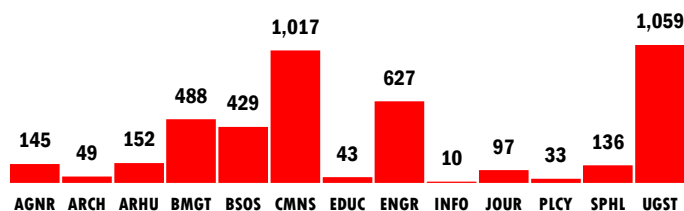
#### 6-YEAR GRADUATION RATE (FALL 2013 COHORT):
