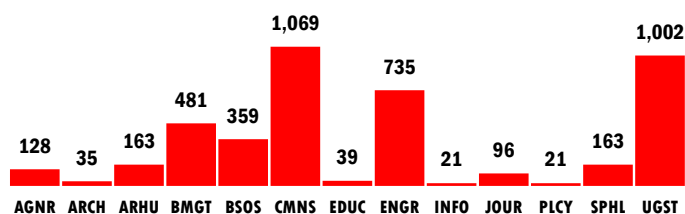
6-YEAR GRADUATION RATE (FALL 2014 COHORT):
